Confirmation of Candidate Affidavit Filing

On 5/16/2023, you submitted a candidate affidavit to announce your intent to be a candidate for Colorado House House District 48 for the election year of 2024. Your affidavit has been processed by Colorado Secretary of State. Please note that for statewide candidates, excluding RTD candidates, a personal financial disclosure is due to the Secretary of State within 10 days of the candidate affidavit, if one has not already been filed.

You will be receiving a separate email message with the information you need to access the Online Campaign Finance system. With this information you will be able to file candidate disclosure reports. The user ID and password are confidential and are intended for use by the candidate only and should be guarded to prevent unauthorized use.

Please review your reporting schedule online for future report due dates.

Prior to accepting campaign contributions, candidates must form a candidate committee. Once a candidate committee is formed, all contributions received and expenditures made are reported on committee reports and not through candidate reports. When a candidate forms a committee, the committee will be assigned a committee ID number and issued a different user ID and password.
